Accommodations

CPB 2011 Annual Meeting attendees need to make their own reservations by calling the Sheraton Westport Chalet at (314) 878-1500 and mention the Central Plant Board Meeting. The room rate is \$99 (+ 14.866%). Or you can make your reservations online at www.starwoodmeeting.com/Book/modeptagr Reservations must be made by **Friday, February 7, 2011** to obtain the group rate. Please make your reservations early to ensure accommodations.

The Sheraton Westport Chalet offers **free** on-site parking and a **free** shuttle to/from Lambert-St. Louis International Airport which is only a few minutes away. **Free** wireless internet is also available to overnight hotel guests registered for the meeting.

Surrounding the hotel are the shops, restaurants and clubs of Westport Plaza with a wide variety of eating and entertainment options. Visit Westport's website at www.westportstl.com.

Transportation/Directions

If you plan to fly, Lambert-St. Louis International Airport (STL) is only 10 minutes away from the hotel. The Sheraton Westport Chalet provides a free shuttle to/from the airport and runs every half-hour from 6:30am to 11:00pm every day. If you fly into the Main Terminal, the shuttle will be near baggage claim at Gate 18. If you are flying into the Southwest Terminal, the shuttle will be at Gate 15. Since the shuttle runs on a regular and frequent schedule, there is no need to call the hotel for pick-up. However, you may call the hotel if needed at 314-434-5010.

If you plan to drive, take I-70 to I-270 South to Dorsett Road. Turn left on Dorsett Road. Turn right on Progress Parkway. Continue straight ahead into Westport Plaza. Driving directions and map are available at the hotel website here: www.starwoodmeeting.com/Book/modeptagr.

Tour

A Wednesday afternoon tour will bring us to the world-famous Gateway Arch, officially named the Jefferson National Expansion Memorial. The National Park Service is currently making plans to redesign the landscape at the arch. The threat of emerald ash borer factors into the Arch landscape which currently is composed of 39% ash trees. The tour will include a walking

tour of the grounds with discussion of their pest management techniques, so dress appropriately!
