



Welcome to the 90th Eastern Plant Board Meeting!

You are cordially invited to attend the 2015 Eastern Plant Board meeting will be held April 7—9 in Portsmouth, New Hampshire. The Cooperative Agricultural Pest Survey and the Eastern Chapter of the Horticultural Inspection Society will once again be joining us in hosting concurrent meetings with their members.

About Portsmouth

Settled in 1623, Portsmouth served as a focal point on the eastern seaboard until the late 1800's when the shipping industry declined with the rise of the railroads. Portsmouth sits near the mouth of the Piscataqua (Pis·cat·a·qua) River which divides New Hampshire and Maine. Today, Portsmouth is a city of roughly 21,000 people and is home to the country's first naval ship yard, which sits at the mouth of the Piscataqua and employs more than 4,600 workers.

The city is known for its beauty, walking trails, historic buildings, sidewalk cafes, culinary delights, live music and shopping. There are museums, a waterfront park, deep sea fishing, whale watching, and the Isles of Shoals Steamship Co.

The COAST Trolley service makes frequent stops throughout the city and the surrounding areas for \$1.50.

Getting to Portsmouth

- Logan International Airport (BOS) in Boston, MA is 60 miles south of Portsmouth Sheraton Harborside Hotel.
- Portland International Jetport (PWM) in Portland, ME is 50 miles from the Portsmouth Portsmouth Sheraton Harborside Hotel.
- Manchester-Boston Regional Airport (MHT) in Manchester, NH is 50 miles from the Portsmouth Sheraton Harborside Hotel.

Driving Directions to Portsmouth Sheraton Harborside Hotel:

- From Logan International Airport (BOS) - Take Interstate 95 N to Exit 7. Turn right off the exit and proceed for approximately 1.2 mile. Bear right at the blinking light and the hotel entrance is approximately 50 yards on the left.
- From Manchester Airport (MHT) - Take route 101 East to Interstate 95 North to Exit 7. Turn right off the exit and proceed for approximately 1.2 mile. Bear right at the blinking light and the hotel entrance is approximately 50 yards on the left.

Parking in Portsmouth

Parking is available at the hotel as valet (\$21/day) and self (\$18/day). There are additional lots and parking garages within walking distance to the hotel. Prices and allowable durations of stay vary. Additional information can be found at parkportsmouth.com/.

Weather and Attire

Weather in New Hampshire in early April is very unpredictable! Conditions can vary from winter caps to sunhats. Average temperatures in Portsmouth for the week of the meeting have daily lows in the mid 30s and highs in the mid 50s. Because Portsmouth is on the water, ocean breezes can make the air feel even cooler. It is generally cloudy that time of the year, with about a 45% chance of precipitation on any given day—there is a 10% chance that the precipitation will be as light snowfall. When there is snow remaining on the ground, there is an average depth of about 3 inches. Be prepared with layers and a warm exterior layer. For the tour, expect similar weather. Because the tour will be in the farther from the coast, there may be increased probability of snow and snow remaining on the ground.
