Official control is a regulatory mechanism that addresses the application of phytosanitary procedures for pests that are not widely distributed in the country. Official control impacts interstate movement of commodities and articles from areas where a pest is known to occur and provides for similar treatment of commodities being exported to the United States. Ms. Schuble will establish relationships with many APHIS partners to articulate requirements and leverage resources for official control.
